Office Helper

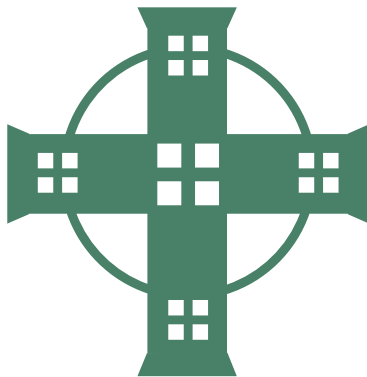
Helpers are needed occasionally for assembling mass mailings, shredding, data collection, and small projects.
